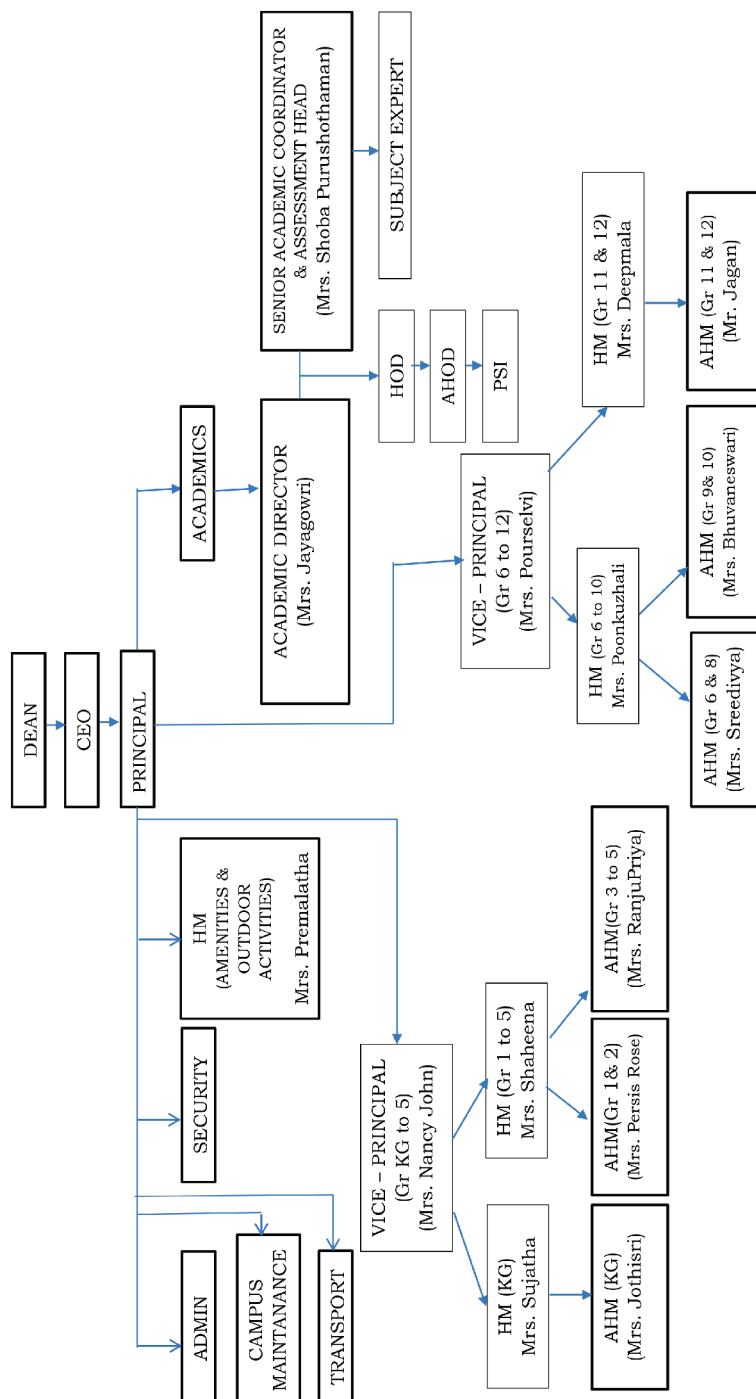

- I. It is essential to respect the school rules and policies and maintain the dignity and decorum of the school.
- ii. It is mandatory that every child should come to school in complete uniform on all working days or whenever they enter into the school premises. (Neatly pressed uniform with trimmed nails, boys with proper haircut, girls should plait their hair and all need to wear neatly polished shoes.)
Parents can send an extra dress with children of Kindergarten and Primary, to use it in case of sudden illness.
- iii. It is in the interest of the general safety that the pupils are prohibited from wearing any ornaments or jewellery in the school.
- iv. Carrying any valuables, money, electronic gadgets including mobile phone, ipods etc., by the students is not allowed, unless if it is demanded for academic procedures.
- v. Parents can provide ways and means to the children to enrich their language by providing children's magazines, comic books based on mythology etc., and making them to listen to English news debates regularly.
- vi. Parents can mail to **Krmpublicschool@gmail.com / krmprincipal@gmail.com** . It is the right of the parent to get their grievances heard. The Parent – Teacher meeting will be held regularly to discuss about the progress of the children. The Parents are requested to attend these meetings without fail.
- vii. Parents can meet the teachers during FA meets as well as on Friday after the dispersal. Parents can also meet co-ordinators on all the working days between 4.00 and 4.30 pm, Parents can meet the Principal in the stipulated time or with an appointment. Parents are requested not to disturb the teachers during the class hours and their cooperation is very much requested in this regard.
- viii. Parents need to check their ward's diary everyday, since it is a communication mode for the parents and teachers apart from mails.
- ix. Parents must insist on the children to read books from the library or they can give extra books to enhance their reading habit.
- x. Without a genuine reason and proper previous permission, taking leave cannot be encouraged. Medical certificate should be produced for the leave on medical backgrounds.
- xi. In case of any emergency, if the parent needs to take the ward during the school hours, they should come in person and get the proper permission from the authorities.
- xii. **Parents are asked to refrain from sending to school a sick child with any communicable disease.**
- xiii. Parents need to help the child in maintaining their books and note books neatly. File system has been adapted in higher Grades to reduce the overload.
- xiv. Towards the general improvement of the School and the Children, suggestions are always welcome either in person or can be dropped in the suggestion box or mail to the Principal's personal mail - **krmprincipal@gmail.com**.

- xv. Assessment records will be given to the parents during the scheduled Parents-Teachers meeting when (open day) the parents can freely discuss about their ward's development with the teachers.
 - xvi. Fee payment has to be made on time to avoid penalty and undesired consequences.
 - xvii. Students will be assessed through Projects, expositions assignment like self learning - tools will be given often to enhance the child's learning. Parents can support them.
 - xviii. Any change of address, phone no. or email needs to be intimated to the office immediately.
 - xix. School is a holy place. Hence, parents or visitors are requested to enter only in **their formals** and approach politely to get the service done.
 - xx. Parents must respond to any call / circular from the school immediately.
 - xxi. Parents are expected to take part/ involve in all the school programmes and to give the constructive feed back.
 - xxii. This is a secular school and all the religious exercises are carried out here only to inculcate values.
 - xxiii. Parents are expected to be a guide and insist children on doing his/her own projects and home assignments at home and to submit on time.
 - xiv. During rainy days or rough weather period, it may be impossible for children to come to school. The school may remain closed on those days. However, the decision, can be taken only in the morning of the day and **no advance information is possible**. In such a situation of inclement weather the parents can retain their children at home.
 - xxv. Apart from the Govt. declared holidays, any holiday declared by Chennai Educational District, by the state or Central Govt. on account of disturbing situations like strike, mourning, as notified by the media, would be applicable to our school also. To compensate the loss of working days, any Saturday can be a working day.
 - xxvi. Every Year the last working day of February is set to be **the last date for the submission of application for the Transfer Certificate if needed**.
 - xxvii. A Health & Wellness officer is available to attend to any health need of a child and a student counsellor to address psychological need
 - xxviii. Parents need to drop their children in the school on time to avoid unnecessary consequences.
 - xxix. Parents need to bring **Parent ID Card** to enter into the school to pick up their children, for safety reasons and to avoid sending through strangers.
 - xxx. Parents need to involve your wards into as much as possible activities to identify and develop the students potential.
 - xxxi. **Grade 9 to 12 residential reading programme will be held 3 or 4 times in a year to improve their academic progress which is mandatory**
 - xxxii. **It is completely prohibited to bring Luch or any kind during school hours which may disturb the students academic schedule.**
